After Russian rocket attack on maternity hospital



Destroyed healthcare facilities

- 163 hospitals completely destroyed
- **815** damaged by 50-90%
- **596** pharmacies completely destroyed
- 650 ambulances were destroyed or burned after rocket attacks



 160 medics died on the job while providing care to patients



Doctors in the ruins of the hospital

Reality

- > impossibility to visit a family doctor or get help online
- increase in heart attacks and strokes among people ages 40-45
- > complicated laboratory tests, planned operations, supportive therapy
- > a decrease in number of screenings, so oncology is diagnosed at late stages
- increase in lung diseases, tuberculosis due to staying in dark, cold, wet rooms and unbalanced diet
- > 14 million Ukrainian need psyhological help
- increasing self-medication, abuse of painkillers and sedatives
